Questions and Responses

- Q1. The spec states that the tactile characters for the ADA interior signs are to be chemically bonded to the background. In the past we have used MC (Methylene Chloride) to create a chemical bond. This stuff is really dangerous and we do not prefer our staff to use it. It actually states in the invitation to bid on page 89 that MC is banned from use there at the University. Can we assume that the Romark tactile copy bonding adhesive film is acceptable?
 - A1. The alternate adhesive is acceptable as long as it is sustainable over time.
- Q2. The comprehensive location plans show various Exhibit Displays and Graphic Displays, but neither are depicted in the Signage and Wayfinding Construction Documentation dated 10.10.17. Are these sign types part of the scope of work?
 - A2. This project is being bid as two packages: ITB18KO-113 Exhibits/Graphics and ITB18KO-114 Signage/Wayfinding. All graphics and signage locations were shown in both packages of plans as coordination is required for installation, as some elements will need to be installed first.
- Q3. Question pertaining to sigh type ID-2. We see the UF as cut out letters with the blue wall showing thru. Are the lines and dots on the panel face painted? If not these are all individual cut out pieces connected to the wall with individual stand-offs. Please clarify.
 - A3. Entire graphic is incised. Graphics as shown are a placeholder. Final design will not require individual stand-offs.
- Q4. Can we router cut rather than sandblasting the edges? If they need to be sandblasted, can we use baking soda? It'll be less abrasive, but still give the frosted look.
 - A4. Nothing as specified is being sandblasted. The surface of the signs have a nondirectional DA sanded finish. The intent of this finish is to provide a frosted look. Once prototypes have been received, we can evaluate frosted appearance.
- Q5. Several of the signs with raised copy and braille call for 3/8" acrylic subsurface painted. The thickest non-glare is 1/4". We can quote with 1/4" or add a back plate to make up the thickness. Will one of those options work? We can use 3/8" clear acrylic, but it won't be ADA compliant.
 - A5. All signs are finished with a DA sanded finish and therefore there is no glare. Only insert signs specify non-glare and those are shown less than 3/4" thickness.

- Q6. There's no quantity given on the last sign type, do you want us to quote it? We wouldn't produce it with steel sheeting, but we could make a magnetic sign with magnetic and tin tape, is this acceptable?
 - A6. Please see attached revised plans (four pages) and schedule (four pages). There is a quantity of five (5) WF-1 signs and two (2) WF-2 signs.
- Q7. Does a contractor need to be a licensed contractor in the State of Florida in order to bid and be awarded this contract?
 - A7. You will need a GC license if a permit is required. A permit will be required for any work which affects life safety and electrical.
- Q8. Can you confirm that if the bid is under \$200,000.00 per 20.1, a bond is not required for the project?
 - A8. Correct.
- Q9. Can you confirm that Cannon Design will be providing all production-ready artwork files? Or should awarded contractor include budget to prepare final artwork?
 - A9. CannonDesign will provide all production-ready artwork as required. Artwork will be created and full or half scale.
- Q10. Has an overall construction schedule been prepared, and can this be shared? If not, is there an expected start date and completion date?
 - A10. The project will be ready for installation the last week of May and the Center has a grand opening planned for July 1. If this date for installation is not achievable we will work with the awarded company.
- Q11. Will awarded contractor be working with a GC?
 - A11. No.
- Q12. Are bidders/contractor considered prequalified under 00100-2 1.7, or should we submit qualifications with our bid?
 - A12. Submit qualifications with your bid.
- Q13. Item 4(d) of the Invitation to Bid states that payment will be made after items have been received and inspected, but Item 15.3 indicates that monthly invoicing is permitted. Please

- confirm that monthly payment will be made for work performed offsite and materials purchased but not delivered to site in the previous 30 days.
- A13. Partial payments can be made for work performed offsite and materials purchased, but full payment will not occur until after installation.
- Q14. What permits and/or building code requirements would awarded contractor be expected to acquire per sections 4.2.2/4.2.3/13.3?
 - A14. A permit will be required for any work which affects life safety and electrical.
- Q15. Per Item 1.7.B.1 who is the government agency that we need to be licensed through?
 - A15. Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation.
- Q16. Per Item 6.6, the Builder will be responsible for the security of the project. Please indicate the condition and security anticipated for the building at the time of installation so we can plan accordingly.
 - A16. The awarded company will be responsible for securing their own equipment and work.
- Q17. Per Item 15.3, please define "whatever supporting information the Owner or the Professional requests..."
 - A17. Photographs of materials and work completed off site.
- Q18. Per Item 15.10.2, please indicate at what phase of the project a direct purchase program may be implemented and to what magnitude.
 - A18. We will not be using the Owner Direct Purchase Program on this scope of work.
- Q19. Per Division 0, item 1.2, please indicate requirements for good faith efforts for MWBE opportunities.
 - A19. If your company qualifies for this program or any of your suppliers, please list them in your proposal.
- Q20. Will lien waivers be required for this scope of work per 15.3.1?
 - A20. If there is a notice to owner of a lien, then a waiver will be required before final payment.

- Q21. Will any Florida state licenses be required for this scope of work per 15.9?
 - A21. Only for any trade which requires a Florida license per Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation.
- Q22. Where will the kickoff meeting take place, and will this be in-person or can it be performed over conference call per 01014-7 1.11?
 - A22. It can take place via conference call and has not been scheduled.
- Q23. Does the project manager need to have OSHA 30 certification? (p.63)

A23. No.

Q24. Will criminal background checks be required for each employee that is on-site? (p.71)

A24. Yes.

Q25. Will there be a requirement to submit a Solid Waste Management Plan? (pg.100)

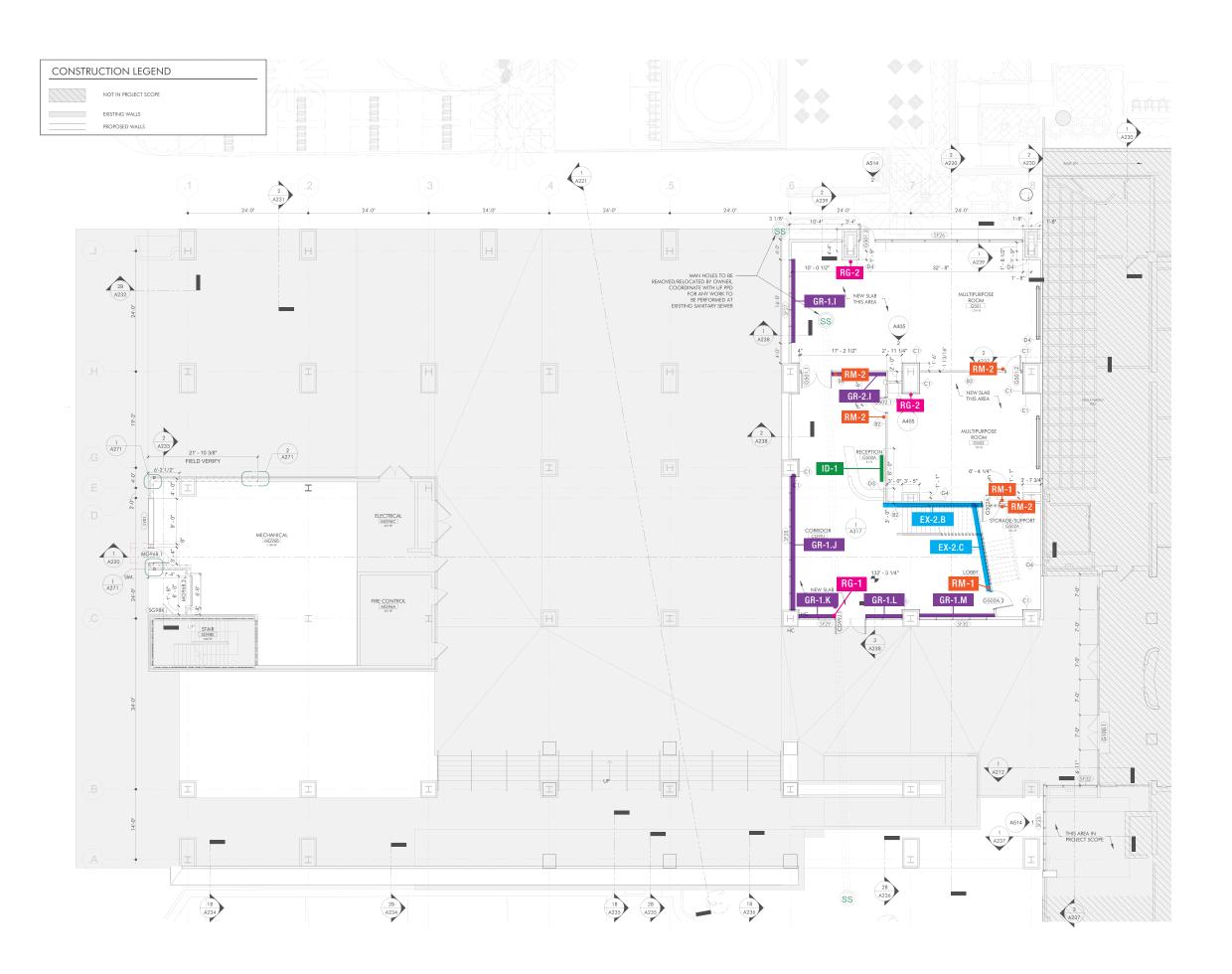
A25. No.

Q26. The contract mentions a requirement for builder's risk insurance. This type of insurance is not pertinent to the scopes required in these contracts and we have had trouble getting this coverage in the past. In previous projects our installation floater has been an acceptable substitute. May we use the installation floater in lieu of builder's risk for this project? (p.51)

A26. Yes.

- Q27. As an out of state company, will we be required to pay Florida use tax?
 - A27. Depending on where materials are purchased, contractor may be required to pay Florida sales or use tax. See Florida Department of Revenue's website for more information on Florida sales and use Tax.

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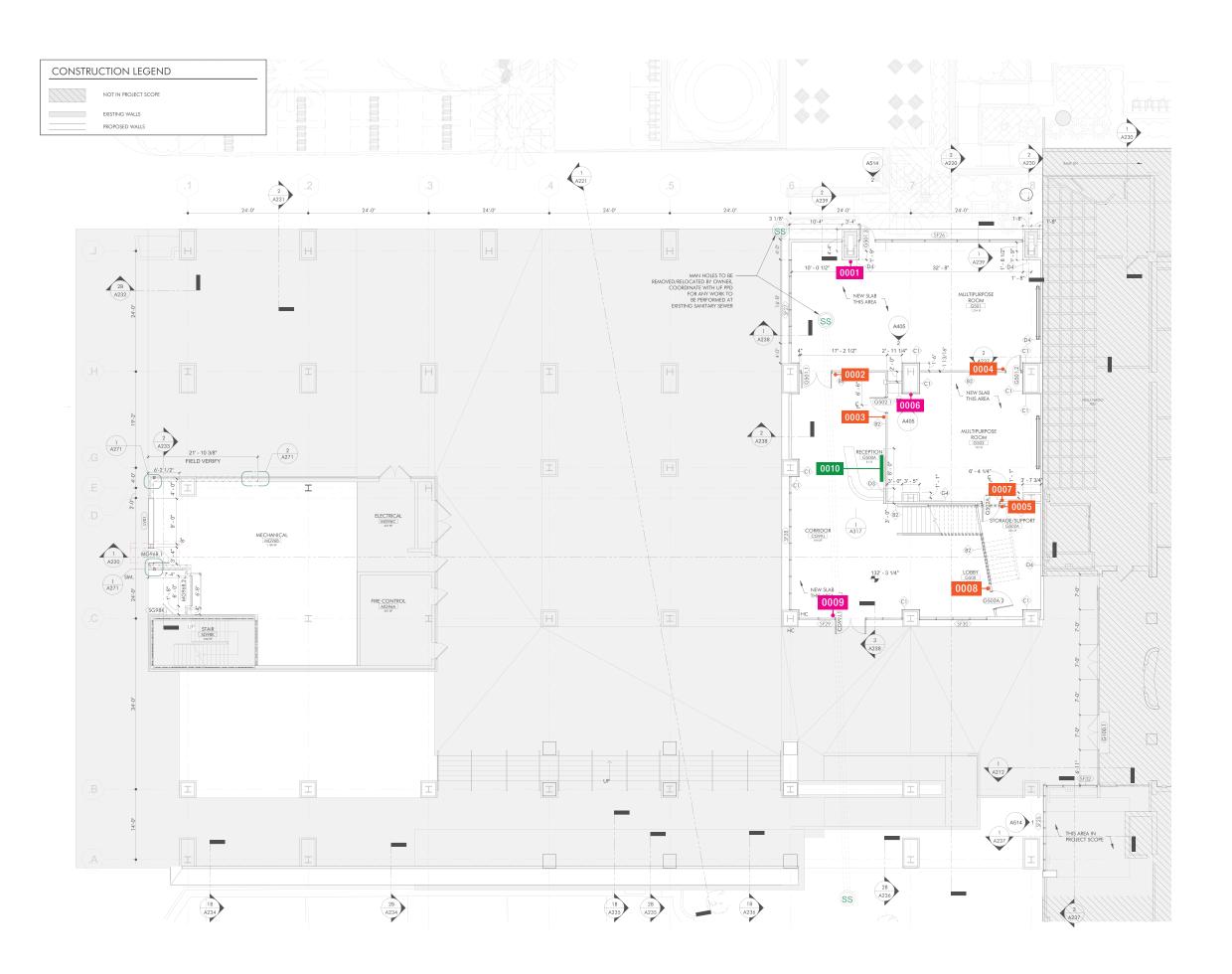
