

Xerox Print Driver TIPS

These changes may be necessary due to the SNMP v1/v2 protocol being disabled.

Which Print Driver to use.

- 1) For color printing it is usually preferable to use the Postscript print driver family.

Note: Postscript print drivers send the print information to our machine and the machine does all of the necessary work needed for the job to print. This can sometimes cause the printer to print slower as the machine works preparing each page to print.

- 2) For faster page delivery PCL based print drivers generally work best.

Note: PCL print drivers make use of the processing power of the users workstation, to preprocess the print data before it is sent to the machine. The machine does less work preparing the job to print and therefore prints faster.

- 3) Global Print Drivers vs Product Specific print drivers.

Note: Global Print Drivers are designed to reduce the number of drivers needed to support multiple models.

Note: Global Print Drivers are updated generally on a six month cycle.

- 4) Product Specific print drivers are smaller in size.
